

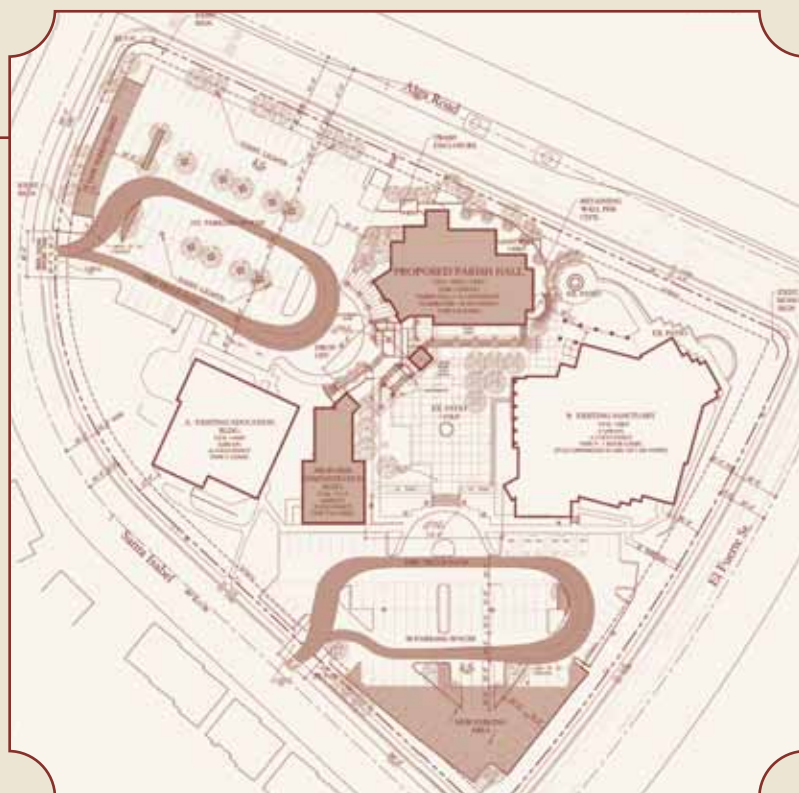
## mission statement

## How Can I Make My Pledge

**Pledges Via Cash or Check** • Simply complete your pledge card by selecting the amount of your pledge and down payment. Make sure to select your method of payment, i.e., monthly, quarterly, semi-annual or annual payments. Please make checks payable to St. Elizabeth Seton Building Fund. You will be sent payment reminders and a special payment envelope in accordance with the payment plan you choose.

**Gifts of Stock** • The Roman Catholic Bishop of San Diego is the "corporation sole" for all parishes in the Diocese; therefore, all stock gifts must be transferred through the Diocese of San Diego prior to being liquidated. Donors can use their own broker/agent to transfer and sell the stock. If the stock has been held long-term (over one year), the donor does not have to pay capital gains tax on the stock and is allowed a tax deduction for the full value of the stock at the time of transfer. The stock must first be transferred to the parish (via the Diocese of San Diego) before being liquidated. Please contact the campaign office for more information.

### Gifts of Property, Life Insurance, Annuities, Wills or Bequests

Families or individuals can make gifts of real estate, personal property, automobiles, life insurance, estate bequests, annuities or charitable remainder trusts. For substantial gifts of property other than marketable securities, the IRS requires an appraisal. Please contact the campaign office for more information.

**Matching Gifts** • Many members of the parish may be employees or former employees of companies that have a matching gifts program. A matching gift program may allow a donor to double or even triple the size of the pledge through employer contributions. Simply contact the personnel office at your company for the appropriate form, complete the donor portion, and then forward the form with your pledge card to the campaign office. We will then complete the form and return it to the company for you.

We would not have come this far in our campaign without the assistance of a special group of dedicated people. They continue to provide us with the tools and direction we need to be successful in our campaign. Our deepest gratitude extends to those who have given the gifts of their time and talents to make this project a success.

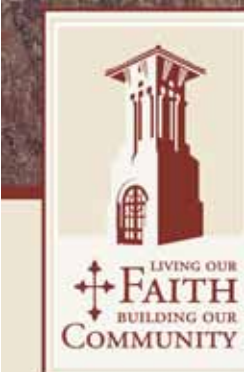
Proposed Social Hall, West Elevation

## As You Make Your Pledge, Please Remember

- Not everyone can make the same size gift, but everyone can make the same size sacrifice.
- Make checks payable to St. Elizabeth Seton Building Fund.
- Payments can be made over a period of 3 years or longer if necessary.
- All contributions to the campaign are fully tax deductible for those that itemize their taxes.
- Pledge payments are in addition to your regular offertory. The Sunday offertory collection pays for the day-to-day operations of the parish, while your pledge in this campaign will be used specifically for building our parish facilities.
